

TENTATIVE COURSE SCHEDULE

- 1) Each course includes **15 sessions**, running **MON- FRI**, from **MON Jan 3 to MON 24 January 2022**.
- 2) There will be no class on **THU Jan 6th** due to the Public Holiday (Epiphany).
- 3) Each class takes place live and synchronous via **Gsuite** within the indicated timeframe.
- 4) The scheduled time frames are based on CET-Central European Time, ITALY and have been optimized to accommodate students from different time zones. Each student is required to calculate the matching local time (<http://www.thetimezoneconverter.com/>) and must be available to join all sessions as scheduled on the syllabus. Attending these sessions is a mandatory requirement.
- 5) Each lesson consists of interactive live sessions, incl. one or more of the following: student lounge, audio-visual material, virtual tours, guest speakers, film excerpts, etc. depending on the nature of the course. Daily extra time is required to complete individual homework.
- 6) For some courses, students must be equipped with specific tools and materials, as illustrated in the syllabus, prior to starting class.
